Detroit Women were winners of Best Rhythm & Blues Band, Best Rhythm & Blues Album, and Outstanding Live Performance at the 2004 Detroit Music Awards. In 2005, they took a record-setting 13 Detroit Music Awards. The group is comprised of eight powerful female singers, including Grammy-nominated Kate Hart and their award-winning band, Motor City Express.

All the women are soloists in their own right, and range from 17 to "is not polite to ask" and cover a gamut of blues and R&B styles including swing, Chicago shuffle and Texas romp. Scanning the long list of luminaries that they have performed with reveals notable names like Ike and Tina Turner, The Rolling Stones, Elton John, Joe Cocker, Hall and Oates and Etta James.

The Detroit Metro Times has included the Detroit Women in their list of the most influential regional artists of the last 100 years. Their live shows have the fire and energy bursts of a sonic flame thrower. They are a spine tingling, cage rattling hit at every festival that they play and even the stingiest critics are showering them with superlatives.
